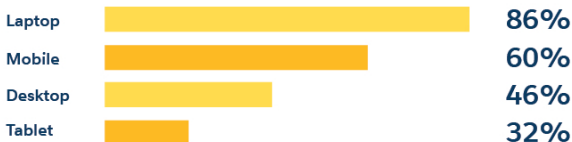

Manage members & configure platform settings

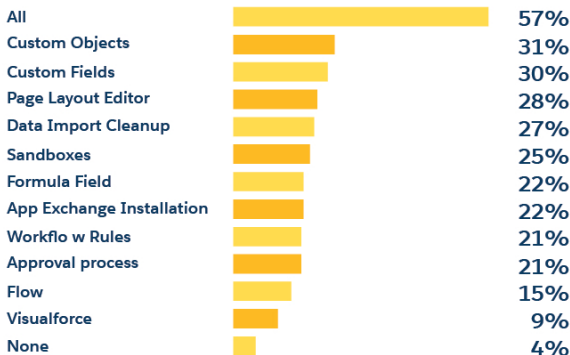

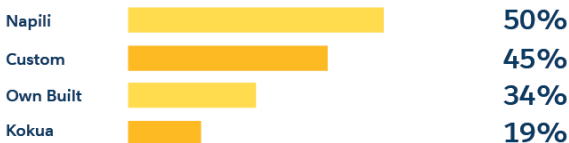
